**Extended abstracts should be submitted by 31st January 2019 to the conference organisers via the MCA website: [www.managementcontrolassociation.ac.uk](http://www.managementcontrolassociation.ac.uk), following the links to Conference 2019 and paper submission. Authors with accepted abstracts will be notified by 28th February 2019, and will be required to submit full papers by 30th April 2019.** Extended abstracts should be not more than 800 words, single line spaced. The title of the paper should be at the top of the page, with the author(s) name, affiliation, and contact details at the end. The abstract should address:

1. What debate are you entering? - identify the background to the paper, previous research (with key references) and the issue(s) you are investigating.
2. What is your argument? - identify clearly what you are contributing to the debate.
3. What evidence supports your argument? - summarise the results of empirical research or source of evidence to substantiate the claims you are making, and summarise how this data has been collected and analysed.
4. What are your conclusions? – identify implications for theory and/or practice.
